ALLARD SEEKS HEARING FOR TYMKOVICH Urges Senate Judiciary Committee to act on Colorado nomination

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) today urged the Senate Judiciary Committee to hold a hearing on Colorado lawyer Tim Tymkovich who was nominated by President Bush for the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals more than 550 days ago.

“Tim Tymkovich is highly regarded and will serve his country with the utmost of patriotism and respect for adherence to constitutional principles,” Allard said in a letter to the Senate Judiciary Committee.”

Tymkovich was nominated by President Bush on May 21, 2001 but the leadership of the U.S. Senate and the Senate Judiciary Committee in the previous Congress refused to hold a hearing on his nomination.

“Now that we have new leadership in the Senate along with the Senate Judiciary Committee, I am optimistic a hearing on Mr. Tymkovich will occur in the near future,” Allard said.
