SENATOR WAYNE ALLARD COMMENTS ON STATE OF THE UNION ADDRESS

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-Colorado) made the following comments Wednesday evening after attending President Bush’s State of the Union Address:

“President Bush tonight continued to challenge Congress to address the critical issues of our time: Social Security, the war on terrorism, and strengthening our economy.

“I agree with him that we need to continue the fight for freedom and democracy in Iraq and Afghanistan. We need to ensure the long-term solvency of the Social Security program for our children and grandchildren, and we need to strengthen our economy by addressing the deficit.

“He has asked Congress to put aside partisan posturing and deal with Social Security. Those who were in favor of Social Security reform under the Clinton administration, yet are opposing it under the Bush administration, are not cooperating in a bipartisan manner for the good of our country.

“I also agree we need to continue to simplify the tax code, work on legal reform, bolster our energy supplies and strengthen education, especially vocational education.”
