## ALLARD'S REACTION TO POWELL'S PRESENTATION TO THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL SAYS EVIDENCE IS STRONG AND DECISIVE AGAINST IRAQ

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO), a member of the Senate Armed Services Committee, made the following comments today concerning Secretary of State Collin Powell's presentation on Iraq to the United Nations Security Council.

“Secretary of State Powell provided chilling and irrefutable evidence of Iraq's continued efforts to obtain and produce weapons of mass destruction,” said Senator Allard. “Using previously classified communication intercepts, satellite photos, and reports from Iraqi informants, he laid out a clear and convincing case that Iraq is in violation of United Nations Security Council resolution 1441.”

“Saddam Hussein has not disarmed, he has not ended his links to Al Qaeda terrorists and has not ended the repression of his people as required by numerous United Nations resolutions,” added Allard. “I agree with Secretary Powell's statement that the United Nations risks becoming irrelevant by failing to act effectively and immediately on the evidence put before the Security Council on Iraq.”
