BROOMFIELD TO RECEIVE FEDERAL FUNDS FOR WADSWORTH INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS ALLARD HELPS SECURE \$3.75 MILLION FOR PROJECT

Washington, D.C. – Broomfield will receive money for improvements to the Wadsworth interchange. The funds were allocated in the Omnibus budget bill passed by congress for FY 03. The funding for the new interchange was strongly supported by U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO).

“I am extremely pleased we were able to get this important project funded,” said Allard. “This has been a top priority of mine, to get this included in the Omnibus Appropriations is a victory for the Broomfield community,” Allard added.

“This is great news for Broomfield,” Mayor Karen Stuart said. “This money is a direct result of the work of Senators Wayne Allard and Ben Nighthorse Campbell. We also had support from Tom Norton, executive director of CDOT (Colorado Department of Transportation), which I am sure helped our cause,” said Stuart.

The new allocation supports the overall multi-modal transportation plan for U.S. 36. The Wadsworth project is a component of Locally Preferred Alternative that is supported by the coalition of mayors and commissioners along the U.S. 36 corridor. Plans are to use this funding for right-of-way acquisition and a final engineering design.
