CAMPBELL AND ALLARD JUDICIAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE SEEKING APPLICANTS FOR FEDERAL DISTRICT COURT ADVISORY COMMITTEE WILL RECOMMEND NAMES TO COLORADO SENATORS FOR JUDICIAL OPENINGS

Washington, D.C. – Colorado U.S. Senators Ben Nighthorse Campbell and Wayne Allard announced they have formed a Judicial Advisory Committee and are seeking applications from individuals for the current openings on the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado.

"With a new President and administration, Senator Campbell and I felt that we needed to put in place a process to fill the current vacancies on the Colorado Federal District Court," said Allard. "We will be working with the Colorado legal community to seek out as many qualified candidates as possible for the openings on Colorado's Federal District Court."

"It is imperative we move expeditiously to fill these vacancies on the federal bench," Campbell said. "This committee is an important first step in that effort. I look forward to working with Senator Allard and the Bush Administration on the nomination and confirmation process."

The Campbell-Allard Judicial Advisory Committee will begin immediately accepting applications from Coloradans interested in serving on the Federal District Court in Denver.
