## SENATOR ALLARD RECEIVES AWARD FROM INTERMOUNTAIN WEST JOINT VENTURES SENATOR ALLARD RECOGNIZED FOR HIS ADVOCACY OF CONSERVATION PROJECTS

Washington, D.C. – Intermountain West Joint Ventures awarded Colorado U.S. Senator Wayne Allard on Wednesday for his “...personal commitment and leadership for North American bird conservation.”

“I am happy to receive this award from Joint Ventures, one of the most effective conservation organizations in the country,” Senator Allard said. “I look forward to continuing my work with this group on preserving Colorado’s natural wealth.”

Senator Allard helped secure funding through North American Wetland Conservation Act grants for IWJV’s projects on the South Platte River, the most important migratory bird habitat in the state, and in the San Luis Valley, home of the endangered Rocky Mountain Sandhill Cranes.

IWJV is a public/private partnership founded in 1994 with the mission of preserving bird habitat in Colorado and throughout the intermountain west region. IWJV works through unique partnerships formed between federal, state, and local governments, as well as private landowners and conservation groups.
