ALLARD RECEIVES AFFORDABLE HOUSING AWARD COLORADO SENATOR NAMED “CHAMPION OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING” FOR 2002 BY NCSHA

Washington, D.C. – The National Council of State Housing Agencies (NCSHA) has named U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) as their “Champion of Affordable Housing” for 2002. The award was presented to the Colorado lawmaker during their annual national conference in Washington, D.C.. It is the second year in row Senator Allard has received the award from NCSHA.

Senator Allard, who is the ranking member of the Senate Housing and Transportation Subcommittee, was presented the award for his support of affordable housing issues in Congress, particularly his leadership in supporting an increase in the Low Income Housing Tax Credit and Mortgage Revenue Bond authority for states.

“I am extremely honored to be recognized as a ‘Champion of Affordable Housing,’” Allard said. “As the ranking member of the Housing and Transportation Subcommittee, I have worked hard to make sure Congress is enacting legislation that encourages more affordable housing for working families.”
