ALLARD ANNOUNCES \$20 MILLION GRANT DENVER HOUSING AUTHORITY TO RECEIVE HOPE VI GRANT

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) is pleased to announce a \$20 million HOPE VI Revitalization grant that has been awarded to the Denver Housing Authority. This funding will be used to replace aging public housing in the Five Points neighborhood of Denver with new units being built to house more than 1,000 families.
