ALLARD SAYS MISSILE DEFENSE BILL WILL PROTECT AMERICA'S FUTURE

Washington, D.C. — U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO), a member of the Senate Armed Services Committee, today said the Senate's passage of S.257, the National Missile Defense Act, will ensure a "safer America" for future generations.

"We are no longer in a 'cold war' era, we are in a modern era where countries like China and North Korea can develop a missile threat to the United States very quickly," Allard said. "Today's vote by the Senate recognizes this new missile threat to America, and puts in place a policy to respond to this threat. The action the Senate took today will ensure a safer America for future generations."

The National Missile Defense bill was approved on a vote of 97-3 by the U.S. Senate.
