ALLARD ENDORSES BUSH FOR PRESIDENT SAYS TAX CUT & SMALL BUSINESS RECORD GAIN HIS SUPPORT

Washington, D.C. — U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) today said he will support Texas Governor George W. Bush Jr. for President. He said he made his decision after careful review of the other Republican candidates who have expressed interest in running for President in 2000.

“We have a great field of candidates for 2000, but in my mind Governor Bush stands above the crowd,” Allard said. “Governor Bush’s record on tax relief and small business issues, and his efforts to strengthen the American family have earned him my endorsement for President.”

“The 2000 election will be the most important presidential election in a generation,” added Allard. “The Republican Party is going to need a candidate who effectively articulates our vision for the 21st Century. Governor Bush is that individual.”

Allard joins U.S. Senator Ben Nighthorse Campbell (R-CO) who became the first U.S. Senator to publicly endorse Bush earlier this year. Senator Campbell is also a member of a congressional leadership group who are helping organize support for the Texas Governor.
