ALLARD STATEMENT ON JUSTICE BYRON WHITE CALLS HIM “A RENAISSANCE MAN WHO NEVER FORGOT HIS ROOTS.”

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) today issued the following statement upon learning of the passing of former U.S. Supreme Court Justice Byron White.

“In my lifetime, I have never met anyone who experienced more success in a variety of areas than Justice Byron White,” said Colorado U.S. Senator Wayne Allard. “He truly was a modern renaissance man.”

Allard, who grew up near White’s home town of Wellington in northern Colorado, also remembered that Justice White never forgot his Colorado roots.

“Byron White never forgot where he came from and the people that shaped his life,” added Allard. “He was proud to have grown up in Wellington, Colorado, he was a proud graduate of the University of Colorado and he made a point to be available to help any Colorado cause that requested his assistance. Colorado has not only lost a giant in the legal profession, but a great friend.”
