CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS RECEIVES \$5 MILLION IN HUD GRANTS ALLARD CALLS GRANTS GREAT NEWS FOR COMMUNITY

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) announced that the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded the City of Colorado Springs a \$5 million grant.

This award is broken into three grants, the first being a Community Development Block Grant in the amount of \$3,172,000. The second is a HOME Investment Partnership Program in the amount of \$1,791,119. The final is an Emergency Shelter Grant Program totaling \$110,000.

“I am pleased that the Department of Housing and Urban Development has awarded the City of Colorado Springs these grants,” Allard said. “The grants will help low income families with housing and improve public service programs.”

The Community Development Block Grant will be used for housing rehabilitation, public improvements, support of neighborhood organizations, public services, code enforcement and possibly economic development. The HOME Investment Partnership funds will assist with housing rehabilitation, construction of affordable housing and tenant-based housing. The Emergency Shelter Grant will use funds to assist the Red Cross Emergency Shelter.
