## ALLARD PRAISES BUSH'S HOMELAND SECURITY REALIGNMENT SAYS MOVE IS A "BIG STEP FORWARD" IN BETTERING SECURITY

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO), a former member of the Senate Intelligence Committee, today praised the announcement by President Bush to create a new Homeland Security Cabinet level post.

“This is good news for every citizen,” said Senator Allard. “This move is a big step forward toward better protecting the American people from another possible terrorist attack.”

Allard said the reorganization will hopefully lead to better communication between different agencies.

“One thing that is painfully clear, is that prior to 9/11 we had a breakdown in communication between different federal agencies,” added Allard. “My hope is this reorganization will better that communication.”
