ALLARD STILL SUPPORTS MISSILE PROGRAM SAYS EACH TEST GETS US CLOSER TO SUCCESS

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO), Chairman of the Senate Armed Services Strategic Subcommittee, today said he still is supportive of our nation's missile defense program despite the results of today's missile test.

“To ultimately achieve success, one must experience some failure,” Allard said following the missile test. “Today's result demonstrates to me we are pushing the outside of the envelope. Like our nation's rocket program in the 1950's and early 1960's we should expect some disappointments. I am confident as we proceed through the remaining sixteen tests of the program, we will meet success and develop a missile defense system that protects our citizens from missile attacks.”
