## DENVER RECEIVES \$100,000 FOR REDEVELOPMENT OF SHATTUCK SITE ALLARD SAYS EPA GRANT WILL GIVE OVERLAND PARK COMMUNITY A VOICE IN FUTURE LAND USES

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) announced today the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has awarded the city of Denver a Superfund Redevelopment Initiative Pilot award. The \$100,000 grant will be used for planning the developmental uses of the Shattuck Superfund site.

“I am pleased that the EPA has awarded the city of Denver this grant to assist the community in redeveloping the Shattuck site,” said Allard who wrote a letter to EPA in support of the grant. “This award will give the Overland Park community a voice in the development of future land use options in their neighborhood.”

The EPA grant will be used to conduct public meetings and community outreach programs in the Overland Park area to develop future land use options once the chemical waste is removed from Shattuck site.
