STATEMENT OF U.S. SENATOR WAYNE ALLARD FOLLOWING SENATE VOTE ON MARRIAGE AMENDMENT

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-Colorado) made the following statement Wednesday after the Senate vote to proceed to debate on the federal Marriage Amendment.
