SENATOR ALLARD ANNOUNCES DHS GRANTS FOR FIREFIGHTERS IN COLORADO

WASHINGTON, D.C. - U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) announced today the Colorado beneficiaries of the latest round of FY 2004 grants through the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program (AFGP) administered by the Department of Homeland Security.

“I am pleased to announce the latest DHS grants for firefighters in Colorado,” Senator Allard said. “This funding is a fulfillment of the federal government’s commitment to improving emergency preparedness throughout the nation, and will have a positive impact on the safety of Coloradoans.”

In this round of grants, over \$60,000 was awarded to the Palmer Lake Volunteer Fire Department and the Woodmoor/Monument Fire Protection District to assist operations and firefighter safety.

These grants are the latest round of over \$375,000 of federal funding that has previously been awarded to fire departments in Colorado through the AFGP in FY 2004.
