SENATOR ALLARD ANNOUNCES \$64 MILLION IN FUNDING FOR COLORADO WATER PROJECTS

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-Colorado) announced today \$64 million in funding for water projects in Colorado over the next five years as a part of S. 2550, the Water Infrastructure Bill.

“This is great news for the state of Colorado,” Senator Allard said. “As federal water-quality mandates increase, this funding will help provide smaller communities with the assistance they need to comply with new water-pollution control and drinking-water treatment standards.”

The Water Infrastructure Bill reauthorizes federal contributions to State Revolving Loan Funds to assist wastewater treatment and safe drinking-water programs, to be distributed by the state of Colorado. It was recently approved by the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee, of which Senator Allard is a member, and awaits consideration on the Senate floor.
