## ALLARD PRAISES PASSAGE OF TAX PACKAGE SAYS COLORADOANS WILL SAVE \$445 MILLION IN TAXES

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) today praised the passage of the largest middle class tax cut since Ronald Reagan was president. The package would provide \$792 billion in tax relief over the next ten years. The package could mean a \$445 million reduction in taxes to Colorado taxpayers over the next ten years.

“Today, the American people were rewarded for their hard work,” Allard said. “We have provided every American a tax refund, while committing 75% of the current budget surplus to shoring up Social Security and Medicare, and we have also taken the first step toward paying down our national debt.”

“This package will benefit every working Coloradan,” Allard said. “It will mean a reduction of \$445 million in federal taxes paid by Coloradans over the next ten years.”
