WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-Colorado) has named Abraham Villarreal of Greeley as area representative in his Loveland District Office.

“It gives me great pleasure to announce that Abe Villarreal is joining my state staff. He will be a real asset in the Loveland district office,” Senator Allard said Thursday. “I know he will be an outstanding area representative.”
