SENATOR ALLARD SHOWCASES RENEWABLE AND ENERGY EFFICIENT TECHNOLOGIES AT CAPITOL HILL EXPO

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Senator Allard (R-CO), co-chairman of the Senate Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Caucus, spoke Tuesday at the 2004 Clean Energy Expo on Capitol Hill.

“With increasing energy costs and tighter supplies, it is important that we seek to balance our national energy policy,” Senator Allard said. “Renewable and energy efficient technologies are a big part of achieving that balance.”

“This expo is an opportunity for private and public entities to showcase their latest inventions and technologies,” Senator Allard said. “I support continued funding for the National Renewable Energy Laboratory and others to do the research necessary to develop new technology and bring the costs of existing technologies down.

“Together with private groups, NREL and other government-sponsored agencies can help bring renewable and energy-efficient technologies to the market at large,” Senator Allard said.

The Senate Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Caucus, of which Senator Allard is a founding member, has 34 members, over a third of the Senate. Senator Allard co-chairs this bipartisan caucus with Senator Byron Dorgan (D-ND).
