ALLARD TO ATTEND SPANISH PEAKS DEDICATION CEREMONY TO BE HELD AT 9:00 A.M. SATURDAY MORNING

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) will participate in the dedication ceremony for the Spanish Peaks Wilderness Area on Saturday, September 29, at 9:00 a.m. at the Cordova Pass Trailhead at the summit of Cordova Road, which is located 17 miles south of La Veta, Colorado.

Last year, Congress passed Senator Allard's legislation to make the Spanish Peaks Colorado's newest wilderness area, which encompasses more than 19,200 acres in the Pike and San Isabel National Forest.

"I am looking forward to attending Saturday's dedication," Allard said. "The dedication ceremony will mark the completion of a dream for many of us who have worked for decades to see the magnificent twin towers of the Spanish Peaks protected for future generations."

Colorado Third District Representative Scott McInnis will also attend Saturday's event. The ceremony is open to the public.
