ALLARD ANNOUNCES SMALL BUSINESS LOANS FOR COMPANIES DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY THE SEPTEMBER 11 ATTACKS

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Wayne Allard (R-CO) announced today that he has been informed by the Small Business Administration(SBA) that it has a loan program for all small businesses directly affected by the attacks on the World Trade Center and Pentagon.

“This SBA program will help companies deal with the loss of funds due to the terrible tragedies on September 11 and the financial impact it has had on some small businesses in Colorado,” Allard said.

Small businesses may apply for a Economic Injury Disaster Loan if they have suffered financial losses as a direct result of the September 11 attacks or federal actions taken between September 11 and October 22, 2001.

“I encourage Colorado small businesses that feel they qualify for assistance to submit their loan application to their local SBA Office,” Allard added.

Two Colorado companies who were financially impacted by the federal restrictions on Class B airspace have already been awarded loans.

The filing period ends January 21, 2001. Small businesses can obtain an application or additional information on the loan program by calling the Small Administration Office at 1-800-366-6303.
